Dear Parents/Carers,

The Year 9 end of year exams will take place between Monday 17<sup>th</sup> and Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June.

English, Maths and Science exams will take place at specified times and in the sports hall. This is a good opportunity for students to have their first experience of doing an assessment in a large space, as they will do for their external exams. No bags will be allowed into the Sports Hall and the bag room will be P14 and will be open 15 minutes before the exam start time. Writing equipment must be in a clear, see-through pencil case or plastic bag and any water bottles must have their labels removed. There must be silence upon entering and leaving all of the exam rooms as well as during the exam and exam regulations must be strictly adhered to.

The following exams will take place in the sports hall;

Tuesday 18 <sup>th</sup> June	Y9 English	1h45 - P3+4
Wednesday 19 <sup>th</sup> June	Y9 Science	1h30 - P3+4
Thursday 20 <sup>th</sup> June	Y9 Maths Non-Calculator	1h – P1 (Back to lessons P2)
Friday 21 <sup>st</sup> June	Y9 Maths Calculator	1h – P3 (Back to lesson P4)

In the other subject areas, the end of year exams will take place in normal, timetabled lesson times during these two weeks. Their class teacher will inform the students of the specific day and lesson of their exam nearer the time, but students should be prepared for this to take place during these 2 specified weeks. Formal exam conditions will also be adhered to in classroom-based assessments.

Subject teachers will guide your child through the process. Lesson time will be used to tell students what they can expect in each exam and how long it will be. In the run up to the CAT, home learning will be focused on specific revision activities. All resources will be available for students on Showbie. Students will know what topics and skills will be tested in each assessment and will be advised how best to prepare.
