**Aprons for Art & Design lessons**

As part of our organisation to ensure the safety of pupils whilst continuing with a broad and balanced curriculum, we have had to make some changes to how equipment is used within the Design Faculty. Previously we have been able to loan aprons to students for lessons where this is required in order to protect their uniform.

Unfortunately, we are no longer permitted to do this due to the current government guidelines as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic.

We would therefore like to ask for your support in providing the following equipment for design lessons:

- Students in years 7-11 who study Food & Nutrition will require an apron for their practical lessons, which must be brought into school with their ingredients and taken home and laundered upon completion of the practical.
- Students in years 7-13 who study Art, Graphics or D&T will need one apron that they can use for these lessons. For students in Key Stage 3 or those doing both Food & Nutrition and Product design, this apron must be in addition to the apron they use for Food & Nutrition. This will also be their personal apron, which they are responsible for bringing to each lesson when taking Art, Graphics and D&T. These aprons remain the responsibility of the student and cannot be stored at school.
