Dear Students and Parents/Carers,

Please find attached the timetable for the forthcoming Year 12 End of Year Assessment period.

Common Assessment Tasks (CATs) will take place in normal, timetabled lesson time between Monday 14 June to Friday 25 June.

As not all subject classes have the double lesson required for these CATs, there may be cases when the CAT will take place over a free lesson either before or after the timetabled lesson. Please check this carefully in advance and ensure you know where you are going and when for each CAT. The timetable will continue as normal during this period, so all students should attend all lessons as normal. If you are entitled to Access Arrangements for assessments, such as extra time or a laptop, the examinations office will be in touch via email, to explain your specific arrangements for these CATs.

The End of Year 12 CAT Assessment period provides the opportunity to assess material studied over the whole of Year 12 rather than a specific topic in a typical CAT. As such, we do expect students to revise and prepare broadly across the whole year of work. In recognition of the exceptional period of time we have faced in school during the pandemic and the period of remote learning, individual class teachers will be explaining to students, which aspects of the course will be covered in the CATs this year. In addition, useful resources will be shared via Showbie classes to support students.

The End of Year 12 Assessment period not only helps students become accustomed to the more formal arrangements for mocks in Y13 and exams at the end of KS5, but also gives the opportunity for feedback and to identify areas of need before we start Year 13.

To prepare students for exams in Year 13, these CATs will require students to do the following:

- Have all equipment in a clear, see-through pencil case or plastic bag.
- Ensure any water bottles are see-through and have any labels removed.
- Ensure all mobile devices are switched off, placed in bags and bags placed out of reach.
- Follow all instructions given by their teacher.
