If you decide not to purchase a paper copy of the book for your child, they will still be able to access a copy in class which will be borrowed but unfortunately cannot be annotated on.

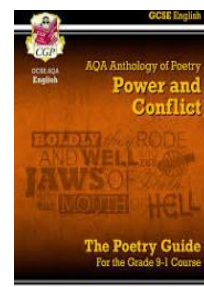
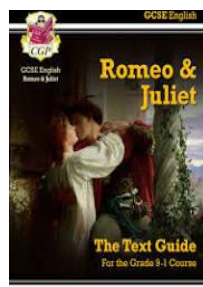
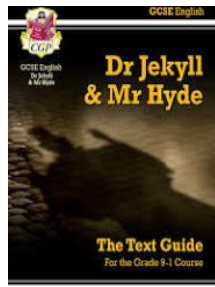
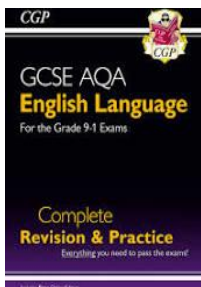
It is important that students’ study from the same published version and we would like to recommend the following Cambridge Schools version:
