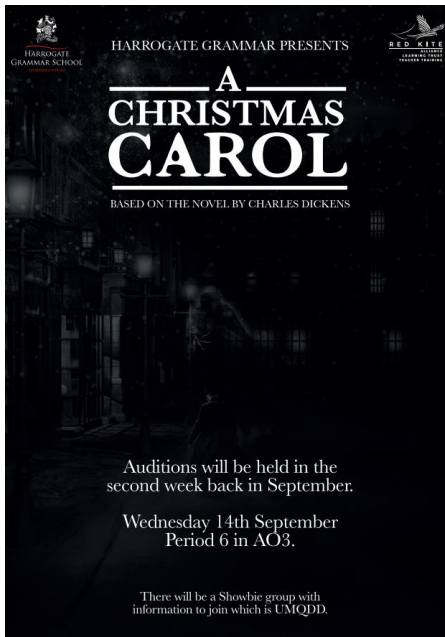
Timetables - these will be available for you on arbor from Tuesday 5 September, please log on and check your new timetable.

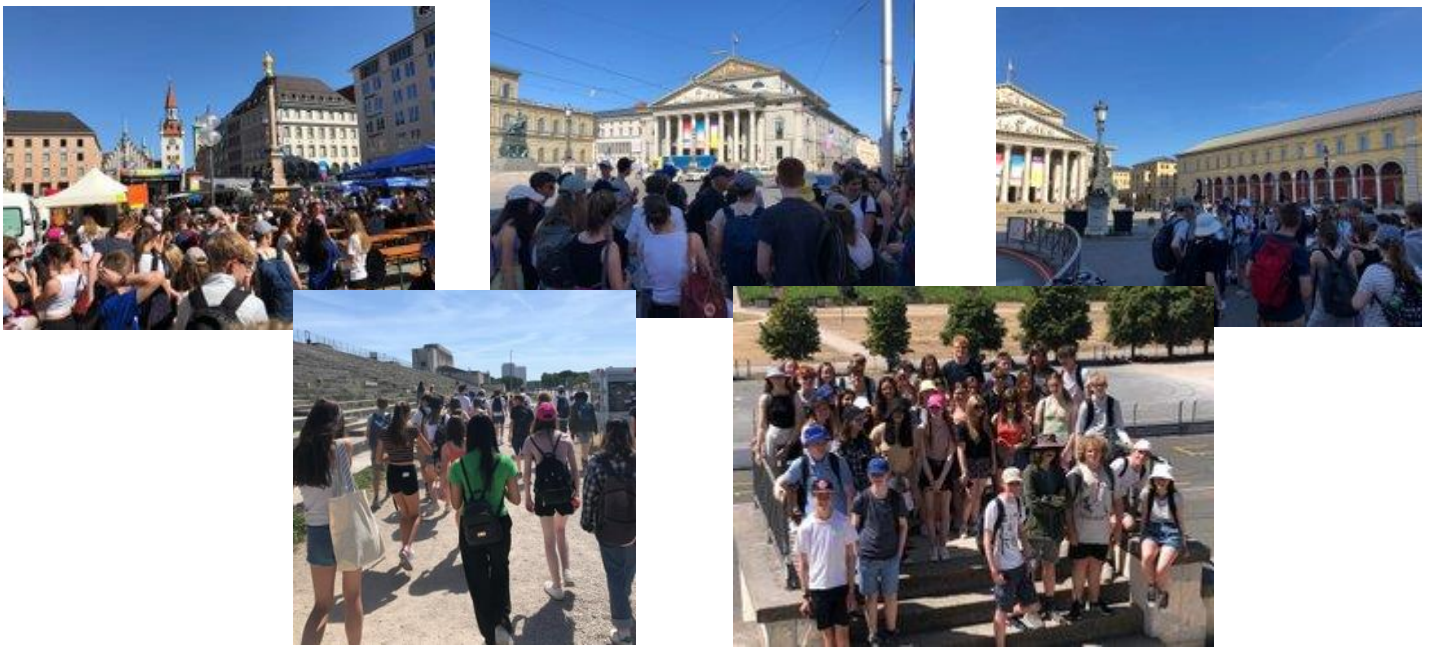
Year 7 French Trip 3
