Admission Form & Key Information

Admission Form: Please complete by 15 March

The Admission Form provides the school with important data, including key information about your child, emergency contact numbers and medical details. This information will populate our management information system, Arbor. All data is stored securely.



We also ask on the form if your child can attend Summer School and ask for the names of two friends.

Initially you will be asked to confirm that you wish to accept the place at HGS, you will then be directed to the Admission Form. Please insert the password HGS 2025 and ensure you select 'New Year 7 (Current Year 6)' on the first dropdown list. Our privacy policy can be accessed via this link.

If you have decided not to take up the offer of a place, please complete the first page of the admission form to confirm you no longer require this place.

Allocation of form groups

Please be aware that we put a great deal of thought and time into the process of allocating form groups. To allow us to do this well, we ask for the names of two friends as part of the admission form. We aim to make sure that your child is placed with at least one of these friends.

Whilst friendships are an important consideration, it is not always possible or in the best interests to place them with a group of their friends. We appreciate that this can cause parents some anxiety and you may not always agree with our decisions.

Please be patient, as making new friends takes time. In our experience this needs the first half term for these friendships to develop and flourish. Taking part in clubs and additional activities really helps this.

For those starting on their own from a small primary school, we will arrange a making new friends visit to school ahead of the transition days.

School Uniform - School Ties

We will share further information in relation to school uniform in the Summer Term.

We have 5 school ties. Students keep the same tie from Years 7 to 11.

For students starting at HGS in September 2025, the school tie design is displayed opposite.







Transition Events

Transition Days: 8, 9 and 10 July 2025

We have arranged for all new Year 7 students joining us in September to spend three days at HGS on Tuesday 8, Wednesday 9 and Thursday 10 July. Please add these important dates to your calendar.

These days allow all students to experience life at HGS.

Students will follow a programme of activities each day to get to know each other and their form tutor, to begin to find their way around school and to sample different lessons with their new teachers.

We hope that being in school for these transition days, combined with the Summer School, provides reassurance ahead of September.

Timings: 8.40am until 3pm.



Summer School: 26, 27 and 28 August

Following the positive feedback from previous years, we are delighted to run our Summer School event again this year.

These three days provide a further opportunity for the year group to meet, experience a range of subjects including Drama, Art and Design, Music, PE and also allow them to familiarise themselves with the school without other year groups in the building.

Across these three days, we will also hand out iPads and spend time setting this up so students can access their email and other apps that are used in school.
