Spotlight - Remembrance

Did you know?

Over 6 million men and women from the Commonwealth served alongside British forces in the Second World War, with over 1 million from European colonies in Africa. Many of these soldiers volunteered, but there were also many who were forced to fight against their will. Approximately 12,000 men and women from the Caribbean served in the Royal Air Force and 22 out of the 34 Victoria Crosses won in the Burma Campaign were won by soldiers of South Asian heritage.





The story of Noor Inayat-Khan is an insight into one person from the Commonwealth who made the ultimate sacrifice.

This Remembrance Day, we remember all those who have served their country to protect its democratic freedoms. We remember particularly the millions of people from the Commonwealth who have served in and alongside the British armed forces since the First World War, defending the freedoms and the ways of life we enjoy today.



Flu vaccinations - Years 7 to 9


The Vaccination UK team will be in school on Friday 14 November in Gym 2.
