Expansion of Free School Meals

We want to make sure all families get the support they are entitled to. The Government is expanding Free School Meals from September 2026, meaning more families will qualify.

We encourage all parents/carers to check, even if you have applied before and were not eligible.

Even if your child brings a packed lunch and does not have school meals, it is still important to apply.

Why this matters

For every child registered, the school receives additional funding (pupil premium). This helps provide:

- Clubs and Activities
- extra academic support
- wellbeing support

Reception and Key Stage One

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive free meals automatically. However, if you think you may be eligible, please still apply so the school can receive additional funding.

Who qualifies?

Your child may be eligible for Free School Meals if your household receives any of the following:

- Universal Credit (*no income cap*)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on

If you are unsure, it is still worth checking. All applications are confidential and will not affect any benefits.
