

<b>Subject</b>	<b>A Level German</b>
<b>Context</b>	<p>The bridging material comprises section A grammar tasks and section B tasks about the German film, das Wunder von Bern.</p> <p>These tasks are to recap key work on tenses from GCSE and to prepare you for the cultural work we do on various topics throughout the course along with A Level work on essay writing about films and literature. Materials are provided in paper form/on Showbie (code QZ3ME) and copies of the film on DVD will be loaned from the MFL department.</p>
<b>Securing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read through the grammar notes provided about past, present and future tenses (section A).</li> <li>• As part of this, make sure you know all present tense regular verb forms and the conjugation of sein, haben and werden.</li> <li>• Learn the task 2 film vocabulary (Section B).</li> </ul>
<b>Processing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete the 30 translations in the 3 tenses to demonstrate your knowledge of these (Section A).</li> <li>• Complete the film tasks 1 and 2 (Section B).</li> </ul>
<b>Exploring</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Watch the film and complete tasks 3 - 8, including writing your own 150 word film review (Section B).</li> </ul>
<b>Reviewing</b>	<p>Reflect on what you have learned through this work by doing the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Note down 5 new things that you found most interesting.</li> <li>• What did you find most challenging and what did you feel most confident with?</li> <li>• Write down 3 questions that you would like to ask your teacher about the topic area(s) that you have been introduced to.</li> </ul>
