School will finish at 2.30pm on Friday 17 July, school buses have been asked to arrive one hour earlier than usual.



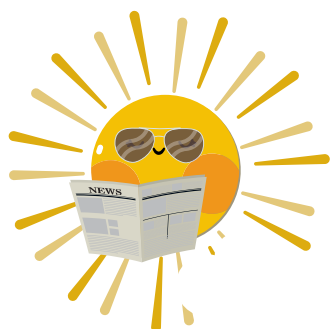
The World Cup Find Freddo Frog Competition Continues Next Week

Year 12 - Preparing for World of Work Week (13-17 July)

The final week of the academic year is set aside for work experience.

Students who are participating in a work experience placement have completed the required administrative processes, and school is completing the final health and safety checks to ensure that these placements can go ahead. Contact will be made with students and employers during the placement, and students will be expected to complete the Work Experience Logbook during the week.

Students who have signed up to virtual work experience opportunities will be allowed to complete these from home to ensure they have a quiet environment to focus on their individual tasks. Students are welcome to come in to school to complete these tasks if they would prefer. All students will be contacted by a member of the Sixth Form Team during this week and will also be expected to complete the Work Experience Logbook.

Year 12 Bridging Work

Each subject area will set bridging work to complete over the summer in preparation for the start of Year 13. This is intended to provide a clear focus for students as they start the second phase of their courses. Work will be set on Showbie and through Arbor, and students are expected to complete the work in advance of their first lesson in September.

Exam results

Students who sat external examinations this summer will receive their results on Thursday 13 August. Results can be collected from the Forum from 10am on that day. Grades for students who have completed an EPQ this year will be published in January.

Results for GCSE English or Maths will be available to collect on Thursday 20 August from 9am.
