Year 8 Battlefields Trip 2023

The History Department is delighted to be offering an exceptional opportunity for students to take part in our four-day visit to the First World War Western Front Battlefields in Belgium and France.

This is a long-standing trip and is always very popular, giving students the opportunity to appreciate the realities of the First World War. It is a packed trip where students will visit the following: Serre & the Accrington Pals' Trench, Passchendaele Memorial Museum, Lochnagar, Ovillers-La-Boisselle (Donald Bell VC), Passchendaele Ridge, Newfoundland Memorial Park, Thiepval, Ulster Memorial Tower, Essex Farm Cemetery & Dressing Station, Tyne Cot Cemetery, La Boisselle, Gordon Dump Cemetery, Pilkelm Ridge, Langemark Cemetery and Menin Road South Military Cemetery.

Students will leave HGS on the afternoon of Thursday 18 May and return to HGS on Sunday 21 May 2023, timings and a full itinerary to be confirmed at a later date.

Students will require a current passport with at least 6 months remaining before expiry at the time of the trip and a GHIC (Global Health Insurance Card). If your child requires a GHIC, they can be obtained free of charge from the NHS Website. Websites trying to sell them should be avoided. If your child does not hold a British passport, you will need to check if any other documentation is required for entry to Germany.

From a COVID-19 perspective, there are currently no entry restrictions for France or Belgium. If this situation were to change, we would let you know as soon as possible. It would then be the parent/carer's responsibility to ensure that the appropriate documentation is acquired to meet the entry criteria.

Expression of Interest

If your child would like to take part in this trip, please complete an expression of interest form by clicking here-by-Wednesday-16 November 2023. In the event the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated on a random basis and Parents/Carers will be notified if their child has secured a place by Monday 21 November 2022. If unsuccessful at this stage, your child will be added to a reserve list.

Cost of the trip

The total cost for the trip will be £450, which includes all travel, accommodation, the services of an experienced tour guide, entry fees to museums and all meals. Any surplus would be returned to families in due course.









Payment schedule

Once you have been notified that your child has secured a place on the trip, please pay via our online payments system, <u>Scopay</u>, in line with the payment schedule below.

- Initial non-refundable deposit of £150 due by Friday 2 December 2022
- Second Instalment of £150 due Tuesday 28 February 2023
- Final Instalment of £150 due Friday 31 March 2023

If you would prefer to pay in smaller instalments, or one lump sum, that is possible through our online payment system but please ensure that these are received in line with the set payment deadlines.

If you would like to make an additional voluntary contribution to support children from families on low income to participate in this trip and other trips like this, there is a payment option available on Scopay under 'Additional Trip Voluntary Contribution.' Any donation you are able to make is greatly appreciated.
